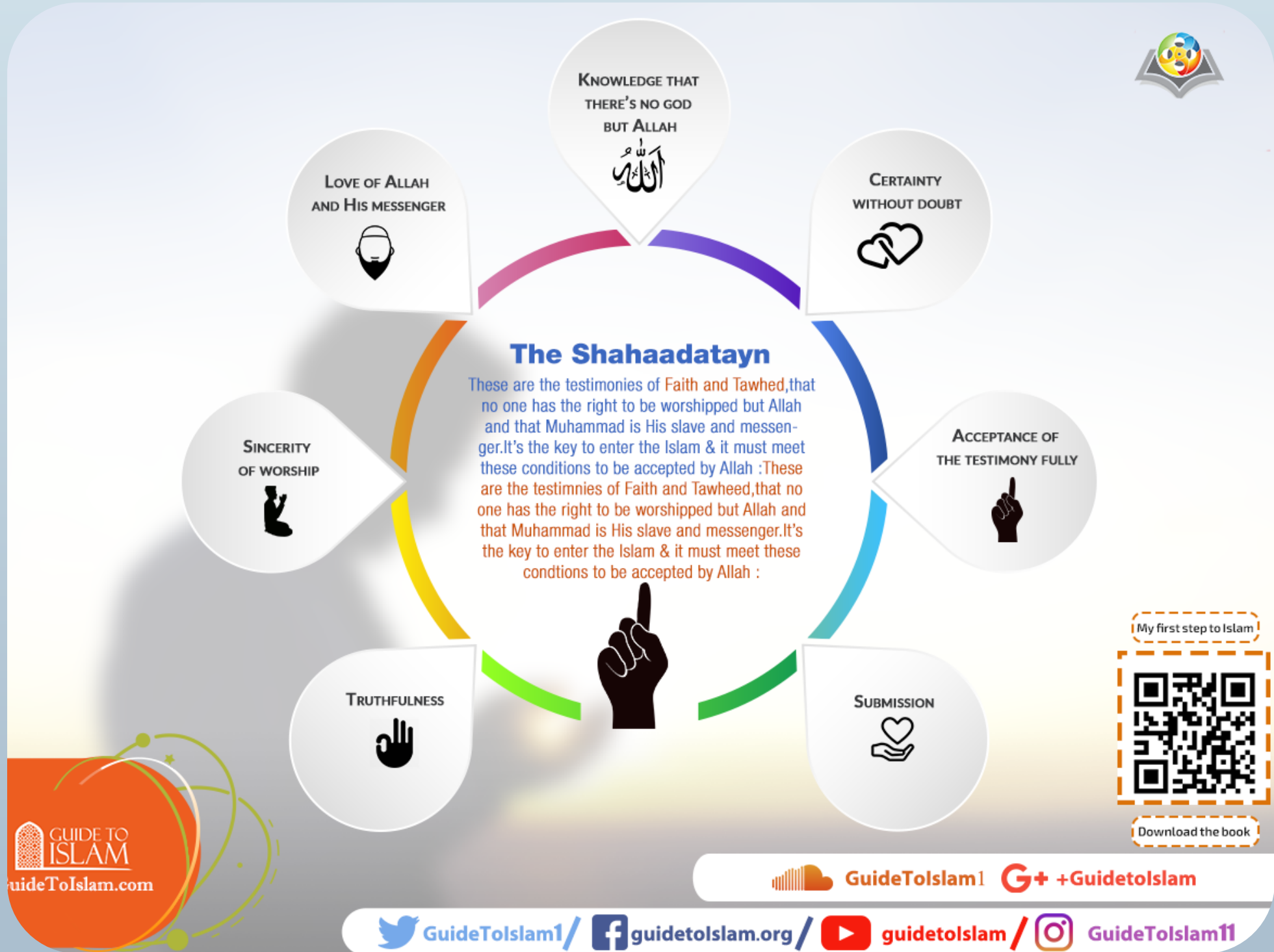

1-The Testimony of Faith



These are the testimonies of Faith and Tawheed, that no one has the right to be worshipped but Allah and that Muhammad is His slave and messenger. It's the key to enter the Islam & it must meet these conditions to be accepted by Allah :

- 1) Knowledge that there's no god but Allah
- 2) Certainty without doubt

It's from SUNNAH that one does the following : -a person takes a complete bath(ghusl) then perform a two-unit prayer -then he must how to perform WUDHU before the prayer or TAYAMMUM(Dry ablution) in the absence of water -then establish the prayers at their exact time as it's the backbone of the religion.

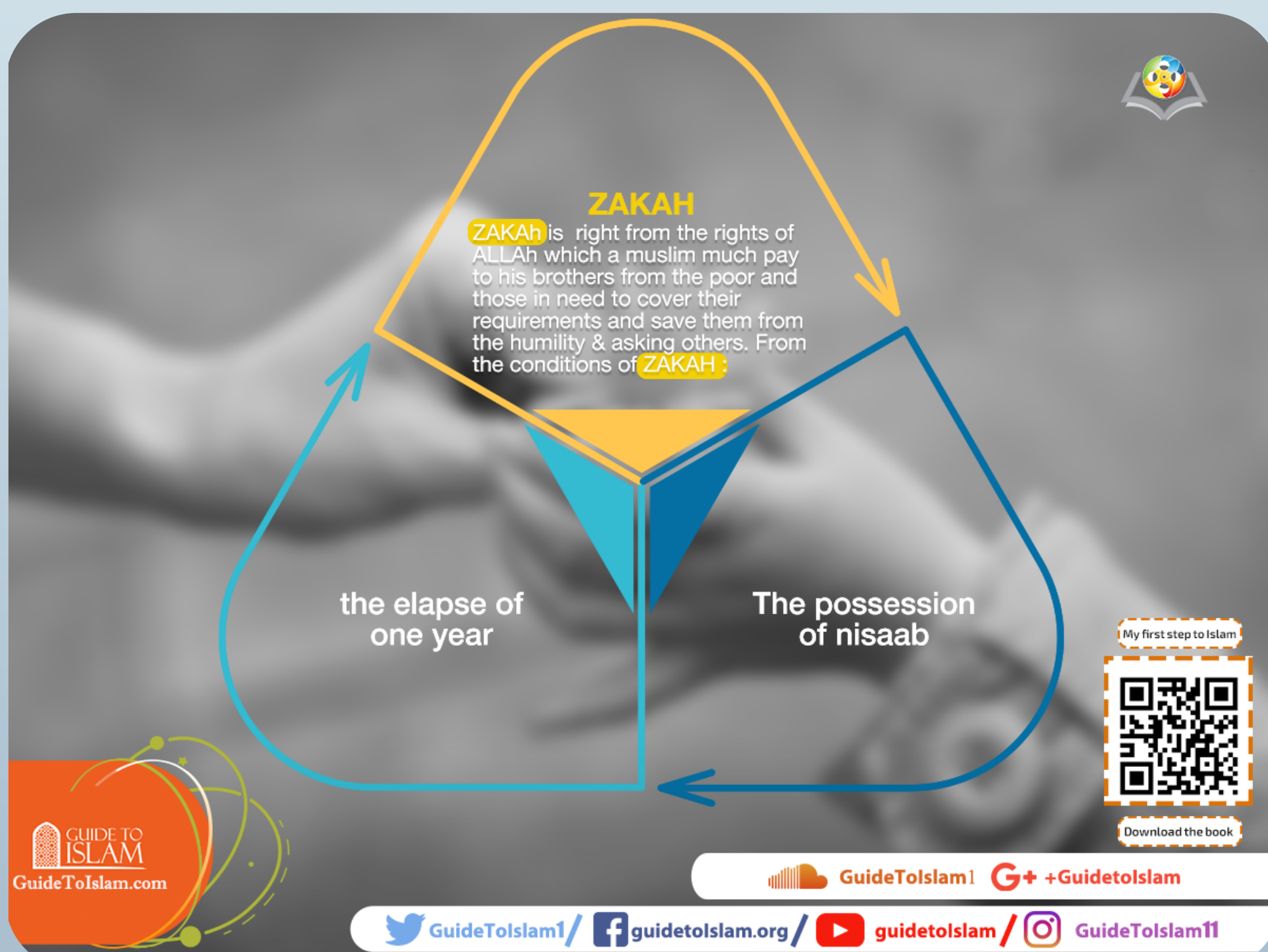
